With a background in architecture, and a commitment to the sustainable growth of cities, Eric Mann applies an integrated approach to his role as an urban designer.

Currently Eric is part of a team commissioned to plan and design for the sustainable growth of Halton Region. He is also a project manager for the certification of Waterfront Toronto developments under the LEED ND rating system, and he is developing a masterplan to guide the growth of the University of Waterloo.

Prior to joining Urban Strategies, Eric led project teams on the sustainable design of educational facilities in Toronto, and earlier contributed to a wide variety of projects as an Intern Architect in New York, and London.

Eric completed his Masters of Architecture degree at the University of Waterloo. His research explored how public schools, as planning instruments, lead residential development, and therefore play a crucial role in the Region of Waterloo's re-urbanization corridor strategy. His thesis proposed how to redirect School Board construction capital to support the Region's strategy to curb suburban sprawl, by renovating existing school sites adjacent to proposed infill residential development. The work included an architectural design to renovate a specific school site, capable of drawing young families away from the suburban edge.
