JOE BERRIDGE

Joe Berridge, a partner at Urban Strategies, has played a key role in some of the largest and most complex urban regeneration projects in Canada, the U.S. the U.K., Europe and Asia. His extensive planning for the Toronto waterfront and the growth management and transportation plans for the Toronto region continue to help shape the future of that city.

Joe has played a major role in the regeneration of Manchester, first as strategic advisor to the reconstruction after the 1996 city centre bombing and more recently by preparing regeneration plans for several decayed inner city districts. He is currently strategic planning advisor on the ambitious Sportcity development in East Manchester. He has undertaken similar downtown planning assignments in St. Louis, Detroit and Niagara Falls. He has master-planned several European large-scale developments, including the waterfront of Cork, Ireland and the Silvertown Quays, Royal Docks, Canada Water and Nine Elms developments in London, and prepared the master plan for Governors Island in New York harbour.

Joe has extensive campus planning experience and provides ongoing advice to the University of Waterloo, most recently in the design of their new 120-acre Research and Technology Park. He is providing similar services to the University of Western Ontario Advanced Manufacturing Park. He is leading a number of neighbourhood and city centre plans in Sudbury, London and Hamilton, Ontario.

Joe was responsible for coordinating the master planning for the Trade Centre Complex at Exhibition Place and he was author of the Garrison Common Report for the Waterfront Regeneration Trust, which set the framework for overall planning at Exhibition Place and Ontario Place. He has recently been retained as the lead planner for the Master Plan at Festival Plaza. For almost a decade Joe was the master planning coordinator for Waterfront Toronto, helping shape the future of the Toronto waterfront. He has had extensive involvement in the preparation of Places to Grow and The Big Move; the land use and transportation plans for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area.

Joe has lectured at universities in Canada, the US, the UK and Europe and has served on many urban design award and competition juries. His paper on the failure of Canadian cities to re-invest has helped focus media and political attention on this important issue. He is a much sought after conference speaker, frequent contributor to planning journals, writes book reviews on urban issues for the Globe and Mail and the Literary Review of Canada, and is a regular commentator on TVO's The Agenda. He is a recipient of the Toronto Arts Award and was made a Fellow of the Canadian Institute of Planners and of the Institute for Urban Design in 2002. In 2009 he was appointed to the Enabling Panel of the Commission on Architecture and the Built Environment, the English design review agency.
