MICHEL TROCME

Urban Designer Michel Trocmé, a Partner at Urban Strategies, is recognized for making high quality, physically and socially engaging environments, which highlight a distinctive sense of place and foster a strong sense of community.

With over two decades of design experience, Michel has played a leading role in guiding the visioning, planning and approvals on a broad range of projects in a variety of settings. His work has focused on master planning, urban revitalization, waterfront planning, and regional planning throughout North America, Europe and the Middle East. His architectural background brings a solid knowledge base of building typologies and infrastructure to projects such as Silvertown Quays, a \$3.5 Billion mixed-use development in London's Docklands, which won an international competition.

His designs for both public and private sector clients have been recognized for being visionary and well grounded, providing leading edge solutions to complex problems. He is currently leading a master plan for Toronto Community Housing (TCHC) to revitalize the 18-acre social housing complex Alexandra Park in downtown Toronto. Extensive stakeholder consultation is involved in creating a new vision for the community, with a variety of housing types, land uses, improved accessibility to green space, retail and community services.

His attention to implementation issues leads to positive outcomes such as the first phase in a 10 year expansion of the ExCeL Exhibition Center in London and St. Louis's Gateway Mall Park, the first phase of which opened in July 2009. Current projects include the Philadelphia Museum of Art and the Greater Southern Waterfront, Singapore. He was lead master planner on the Brooklyn Bridge Park Master Plan, in New York which opened in April 2010, and Cambridge Research Park next to the MIT campus which is nearing completion.

Michel regularly speaks at professional gatherings and has taught urban design studios at the Harvard Design School, The University of Toronto and York University.
