WARREN PRICE

Warren Price, an urban designer and Associate with Urban Strategies, brings to his work a background in architecture and extensive experience in urban and community design. His experience includes all aspects of project development, including: facilitation and coordination; site contextual analysis; detailed design and vision concepts; master plans; and urban design and streetscape design guidelines.

Warren recently completed campus plans for Brock University in St. Catharines, Ontario and McMaster University, in Hamilton, Ontario. Warren has also been involved in campus master planning processes at the University of Minnesota, Trinity College, in Hartford, Cornell University in Ithaca, New York, and the University of California, Berkeley. He is currently developing a facilities plan for Brock University and Sustainable Design Guidelines for the Clarington Energy Business Park.

Warren has prepared master plans for the downtowns of Hartford, Connecticut, St. Paul, Minnesota, and Charleston, South Carolina. These plans focus on creating opportunities for growth and reinvestment while supporting a traditional urban environment. For Barbados, he developed island-wide land use and structure plans as well as plans for several communities and the City of Bridgetown. Warren's community revitalization work ranges in scale from individual buildings to neighbourhoods. He has also analyzed development patterns for several communities and presented hypothetical regional development models for the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation. His transportation oriented work includes design guidelines for arterial roads in the regions of Halton and Durham in Ontario, as well as a transit oriented development opportunities analysis for the Regional Municipality of Halifax, Nova Scotia.
