Craig views good urban design as a tool to creatively balance both the short and long-term conditions of our towns and cities. Craig's professional experience in the UK, Canada and the US has provided him with the opportunity to work on a wide variety of projects in a multitude of contexts.

In Saint Paul, Craig was the lead urban designer for the creation of the Central Corridor Development Strategy and the development of 11 station area plans along that line. Craig led the update of the Ontario Ministry of Transportation's Transit Supportive Guideline. The guidelines are a distillation of transit-friendly land use planning, urban design and operational practices, drawing from experiences in Ontario and abroad.

For the Downtown Buffalo Infrastructure and Public Realm Master Plan, Craig developed a flexible Vision Framework and strategic investment strategy designed to maximize the impact of public sector investments to support and catalyze new private sector investment. For the 60 acres Celestica headquarters in Toronto he developed a land use and planning framework for the transformation of the company's urban campus into a new mixed use neighbourhood and employment campus. The plan established a framework for the intensification of the site over time while preserving for the continuation of Celestica's corporate functions on site. He is currently leading the urban design components of the Scarborough Town Centre Master Plan.
